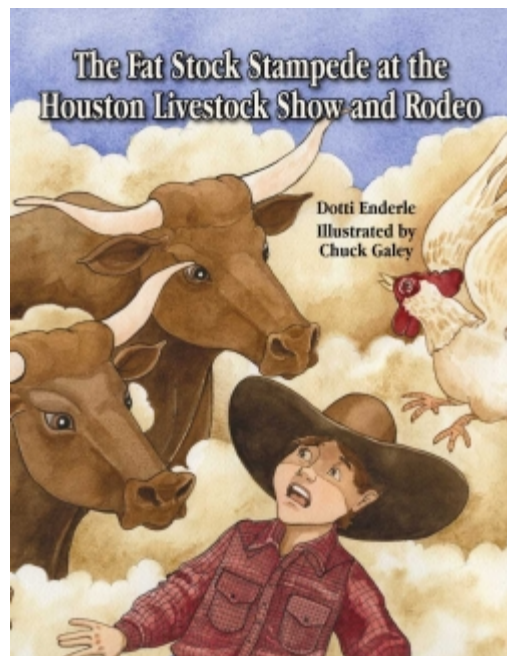
Story Time Tuesdays Series Continues at the Jackson Zoo with Illustrator Chuck Galey
